

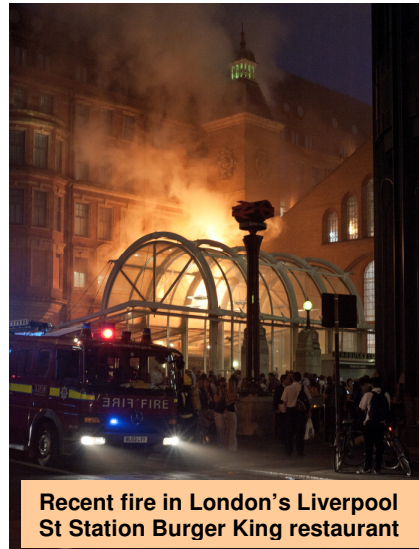
## Indepth Hygiene report Growing Demand for Ventilation System Cleaning Services

In the first six months of 2011, Indepth Hygiene received over 30% more enquiries for its specialist ventilation system cleaning services than in the same period of 2010.

Whilst demand for deep cleaning of grease extract systems continues to grow as more recognise the need to comply with the Fire Safety Order, there has been a notable increase in demand for cleaning general extract and supply (air conditioning) systems in hospitals. In addition, Hospitals' Estates and Facilities Managers have taken note of the increasing evidence that air conditioning systems provide ideal conditions for the cultivation and dissemination of Healthcare Associated Infections, particularly MRSA and C.difficile.

If the fight to eliminate HCAI is to be successful, air conditioning ductwork needs specialist cleaning to eliminate these dangerous conditions.
